How to Write Fractured Fairy Tales - 7 How-to Writing Tips

Use this writing sheet with students to plan the details of their fractured fairy tale. Students will select a traditional fairy tale, then change the point of view of the characters to create a new, creative version of the story.

One of my favorite things to teach in second grade truly has been fractured fairy tales. My students love comparing/contrasting the traditional fairy tale to the fractured fairy tale. We've had a lot of fun reading and analyzing these text to identify some of the similarities and differences as it relates to the characters, setting, problem and solution.

Whether students are reading or writing fractured fairy tales, they'll learn about key story elements as you present these seven ideas for how to fracture a fairy tale: 1. Change the CHARACTERS. Fractured fairy tale characters don't have to be the same as their traditional counterparts.

Discuss how the fractured fairy tale is similar to and different from classic fairy tales. Individually or in pairs, complete a Venn Diagram, recording the similarities and differences between traditional fairy tales and fractured fairy tales. Choose one of the elements from the story map to demonstrate the process, using the class-selected ...

Once Upon a Time Rethought: Writing Fractured Fairy Tales ...

The following unit allows students to explore traditional and fractured fairy tales in order to see stories from a different point of view. Students will use activity to explore fractured stories and to create their own mixed up fairy tales. Students will compare and contrast different stories while writing their own narratives.
