Push the new sensor into place on the engine block. Place the holding bolt backing into the sensor mounting hole and tighten it with an adjustable wrench in a clockwise direction. Push the wiring harness back onto the sensor until it snaps into place. Replace any other components or brackets removed to access the sensor.

The new knock sensor is installed, torqued to the correct specifications, and connected. The vehicle is lowered off the jack stands or the intake manifold is reinstalled per manual. The knock sensor is tested and the vehicle is road tested to ensure proper operation.

The average cost for a knock sensor replacement is between \$298 and \$382. Labor costs are estimated between \$178 and \$224 while parts are priced between \$120 and \$157. Once the knock sensor is determined to be the culprit, the mechanic will simply unscrew the sensor and replace it with a new one. In some cases, there will be electric connectors that need to be taken out before the sensor can be removed, but this not a tough replacement.

You need to lift on the small black part to remove the gray piece, and then you can unplug the large black plug from the throttle body. On top of the intake manifold and towards the rear is the knock sensor harness. Unplug it and unclip it from the manifold, as you'll be replacing this.

Unplug the knock sensor's wiring harness connector by pulling the tabs away from the plug, then pulling the plug off the sensor. Unscrew the sensor from the block, using the appropriate wrench. Step 3 Coat the threads of the new knock sensor with a thin layer of anti-seize compound.

Locate the knock sensor on the back of the engine, just below the intake manifold. The sensor is a round, metal object with a single wire coming off its top. Grasp the wire at the boot with your hand and pull it off the sensor. Set the wire off to one side and place a wrench on the hex portion of the sensor.

Next, clean the cylinder head mating surfaces, lower intake plate, and knock sensor holes making sure to remove ANY debris that might have fallen into the cylinder head ports (I like to use brake cleaner). Replace both knock sensors making sure to torque them to 15 ft. lbs., and then install the knock sensor harness and grommets.
