These are made easier if the assessment scheme is simplified and if every member of the healthcare team uses the same systematic approach.

Post Operative Care. Healing after surgery to the mouth, face or jaws occurs quickly and without complication in most cases. Problems can arise due to the immediate functioning of the facial region: ie you need to eat, breathe and talk during the healing process.
