If you want to read the psalms in a month, another idea is to start on the 1st of a month and then read the psalm for that day and then just keep adding 30. Let's say you decided to do this in June. On June 1 you would read Psalm 1, 31, 61, 91, and 121. On June 15 you would read Psalm 15, 45, 75, 105, and 135.
