His second ship the SS Great Britain was commandeered (borrowed) by the British Government to take soldiers to fight in the war. She made several voyages between March 1855 and June 1856, during which she carried around 45,000 soldiers.

In February 1855, Isambard Kingdom Brunel was invited by the Permanent Under Secretary at the War Office, Sir Benjamin Hawes (husband of his sister Sophia), to design a pre-fabricated hospital for use in the Crimea, that could be built in Britain and shipped out for speedy erection at a still-to-be-chosen site.

Renkioi also showed how infection rates could be reduced by able staff in a well administered, properly designed hospital. The hospital showed lower mortality rates than those of London hospitals. There was scant recognition in the press that Brunel's design was a major advance in hospital design, and a great improvement on the tented and hutted hospitals originally provided in the Crimea.

Renkioi Hospital is remarkable not for any spectacular structural innovation, but for its appropriate and complete design and for the speed and efficiency with which it was planned and built. In February 1855, at the height of the Crimean War, Brunel was commissioned to design a hospital that could be prefabricated in England and built on almost any site by a relatively unskilled workforce.
