### **Socio-Cultural Approaches to the Anthropology of Reproduction**

The basic problem: critique of the study of kinship. The problem with defining 'adoption' for an encyclopedia of anthropology is this: on the one hand, what anthropologists know about adoption is evidence for some of our most central tenets; particularly that kinship is produced through social, linguistic, and legal practices rather than asserted through genetic codes.
