Symbi: Is a poetry form where a poem is written within a poem in which there is a symbiotic relationship...hence the name Symbi. It is a six line (sestet) with syllable counts of 5/5/7/5/5/7. There is a haiku, senryu, or katauta written in the 1st line, 3rd line, and 5 line.

The original sonnet form was invented in the 13/14th century by Dante and an Italian philosopher named Francisco Petrarch. The form remained largely unknown until it was found and developed by writers such as Shakespeare.

Closed Form: a poetic form subject to a fixed structure and pattern; the opposite of open form. Concrete Poetry: a poem that is as much a piece of visual art made with words as it is a work of poetry. Connotation: the implied or suggested meaning associated with a word or phrase. Consonance: the repetition of similar consonant sounds.

Haibun: In the seventeenth century, Matsuo Basho popularized this form of poetry which is a combination of haiku and prose. Katauta: This three-line poem has a syllabic meter of either 5-7-5 or 5-7-7. A katauta is often called an incomplete poem. The form is written as one lover addressing another.

There is, first, the obvious external form of a rhymed, closed couplet in iambic pentameter (that is, five poetic “feet,” each consisting of an unstressed followed by a stressed syllable, per line).
