The Senate Committee reporting on the Federal Trademark Act of 1946 succinctly stated that, "unfair competition is the genus of which trademark infringement is one of the species...All trademark cases are cases of unfair competition..."

The best way to envision the relationship between trademarks and unfair competition is to imagine an umbrella. The umbrella is unfair competition and trademark infringement is one spoke in the umbrella. This is because trademark infringement is a form of unfair competition, that is, fraud or dishonest business dealings in trade and commerce.

The Relationship Between Trademarks and Unfair Competition Law

An injured party brings Federal unfair competition claims under section 43 (a) of the Lanham Act. Unlike trademark infringement claims under the Lanham Act, unfair competition claims do not require any federally registered marks.

Unfair Competition and Trademark Infringement

comprises all other forms of unfair competition. Unfair competition does not refer to the economic harms involving monopolies and antitrust legislation. What constitutes an "unfair" act varies with the context of the business, the action being examined, and the facts of the individual case. Two common examples of unfair competition are trademark infringement and misappropriation.

Unfair competition laws are regulated through a combination of federal and state laws, including court rulings under common law. Taking it back to the United States Constitution, Article 1, Section 8, Clause 3 known as the "Commerce Clause," this section provides the basis for Congress' regulation of unfair competition.
