The UNSC held 60 votes in 2018. 45 resolutions were unanimously adopted, nine were adopted with the support of nine or more members of the Council, and six resolutions failed due to veto or inadequate support by Council members. Of the 60 votes, the United States voted in favor of 57 and vetoed three draft resolutions.

Voting Practices in the United Nations in 2018

On 29 November 2012, the UN General Assembly adopted United Nations General Assembly resolution 67/19 changing Palestine's "entity" status to "non-member state" by a vote of 138 to 9, with 41 abstentions. Some sources claim that these measures implicitly recognised its sovereignty.
